PROCUREMENT OF INTERNET ACCESS SERVICE FOR SULU AND MARAWI REGIONAL OFFICE OF THE NATIONAL COMMISSION ON MUSLIM FILIPINOS

I. REQUIREMENTS DEFINITION / SCOPE OF WORK

The project covers the acquisition and implementation to enhance the Internet connection to Sulu and Marawi Regional Office of the NCMF. It involves the following:

- 1. Engagement of Internet Service Provider (ISP) from NCMF Sulu and Marawi;
- 2. Subscription of up to Seven (7) Mbps download and One (1) Mbps Upload with sixty (60) GB data volume allowance of internet bandwidth via Satellite Internet Connection for Six (6) months to the following office addresses:
 - a. Sulu Regional Office: 2/F Tankee Bldg., Salih Yusah St., Jolo, Sulu
 - b. Marawi Regional Office: OMA Bldg, Peoples Park, Brgy. Saber, Marawi City
- Integration of the proposed internet connections to the existing NCMF's network infrastructure. The winning ISP bidder/s shall provide the necessary hardware terminations and other services required to setup the internet connection. Details of the technical requirements are indicated in Section III and IV of this document;
- 4. Provision of support services.

II. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Bidders should have the expertise and one (1) year experience in internet service provisioning.
- 2. Bidders must have the capacity and ability to provide maintenance services and technical support.

III. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

 Bidder must submit detailed work plan specifying installation design, detailed activities timelines and network diagram in order to determine compatibility with the existing NCMF Local Area Network (LAN) configuration and building's electrical power rating.

IV. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDER (ISP)

1. Pre-Installation

Provide detailed work plan specifying installation design, detailed activities, network diagram (ISP to submit WORK PLAN).

2. Actual Installation

- A. Supply and setup Internet Connection with a speed of up to Seven (7) Mbps download and One (1) Mbps Upload with sixty (60) GB data volume allowance of internet bandwidth via Satellite Internet Connection at the NCMF Sulu and Marawi Regional Office;
- B. Provide necessary equipment from ISP to the office's network cabinet if there's any;
- C. Lead time for installation will be Forty Five (45) days upon receipt of notice to proceed

3. Configuration

A. Configure the satellite, modem and any other necessary equipment to the equivalent Internet connection speed

4. Testing Period

A. The selected ISP shall notify NCMF in writing in seven (7) days prior to the required installation and testing of the internet service connection.

5. Implementation

A. NCMF shall maintain all equipment in proper working order.
